Preferred Product Purchasing Policy

Mike said that the design letter before them is to go in with the final Chapter 85 review. As the abutments to the bridge are not being replaced, the bridge will not be widened. They will put this in the support letter to MassDOT. Chuck made a motion to accept the support letter. Patrick seconded; all were in favor.
