She had listed some action items, several needed public participations also how to improve and also keep safe the open space in Town.

Lake and Pond Overlay District and Conservation Commission: Kate recapped (1) Con Comm met with Planning Bd. the initial discussion was about transferring the LPOD to Conservation; (2) Kate contacted Town Council and came to the agreement that the transfer would be fine. (3) the Planning Board wanted Conservation to vote to accept the transfer; (4) Tom LaBelle did research on jurisdiction and found the Massachusetts Association of Conservation Commissioners manual and wording that specified the zoning conservation bylaws could not transfer to the Conservation Commission. (5) Town Council weighed in and noted Mass General Law C. 40A. The Board members voiced their opinions and asked questions on the LPOD transfer.
