- 2) Discussion of Cat and Dog water spray: After discussion of the photograph from the early 1900s showing a taller spray of water going up between the Cat and Dog, it was agreed to pursue the original spray height.
- 3) The Committee agreed to ask Mark Webber to generate a request for proposal for the restoration work of both fountains as the traffic work will not preclude going ahead with the actual restoration of the top two tiers of the Cat and Dog and the Watering Trough. Kate will follow-up with Marc Volk regarding the RFP for electric, plumbing and masonry. Bob and Carl will assist Mark Webber as needed with a paragraph describing restoration for both works (and casting for the Cat and Dog).
- 4) Mark Webber says that the town has an umbrella insurance policy of \$1 million to cover town works.
