

# *Sewer and Water Minutes*

Don asked for a motion to approve May 2nd minutes and Peter moved to approve them as presented, all were in favor.

The Cat and Dog Fountain looks good and Don thanked Tony and Mike and Mark for their work on it. Don thanked Mike and Tony for being at the Town Meeting to answer any questions that came up.

Town meeting articles updates: For the water plant painting Mike needs to get 3 bids in; In line valves are in for the 2 brooks where water mains run through and will need to be installed. Chlorine analyzers and turbidity meters will be ordered in July. The plant floor/processing area was discussed for a next year article to bring to Town meeting. Foresight Land will be the engineer for Elm and Maple water lines. The engineer at Tuckerman's Bridge did a few more borings to find out more in regards to the existing abutments.

Park St pump station: coming along, every other week Tony has a call with the engineer. Still on target to start mid-July.

I&I study will happen after Labor Day as most of the work is in the Beachwood area and the Stockbridge Bowl area.

Sewer issue in Glendale is ongoing and has not been corrected yet. Trying to get someone to do a trenchless repair with a robotic and do a patch.

Water System Master Plan has a lot of private water lines and hydrants and other things that need to be removed as they do not belong in the plan. Mike is trying to have a meeting and discuss the priorities for the Town listing from the top the most important etc. the list is about 85% done just needs fine tuning.

Hydrants flushing and painting will be happening soon.

A 2-inch fire service will go in across the street at 45 Main soon.

Peter motioned to adjourn all were in favor.
