Installing service pole # 204-1 with anchor & installing additional anchor at pole# 204 to serve 21A Interlaken Road, Stockbridge, MA.

Location approximately as shown on plan attached.




Lessor and Lessee hereby terminate the Lease and extinguish and release all rights, privileges, obligations of Lessee and Lessor under the Lease.
