Sewer and Water Minutes

February 8, 2022

Approve January 4th minutes: Don asked for a motion to approve the January 4th minutes and Peter motioned to accept the minutes as presented.

Averic Rd and Train Hill Rd private sewer update – Paul Sundberg spoke to the Commissioners regarding the sewer line. Several neighbors have expressed interest and their research gave them an estimate of approximately \$15,000.00 per house with 11 homes showing interest. This would include engineering, installation and hook up along with town fees. They have received estimates from two engineering firms. Their questions: 1. Technical approach, gravity feed verses E-One pumps; 2. How to deal with the bridges; 3. Ability to tap into a neighbors' private line; 4. What kind of help can be offered by the Town. These questions were all commented on by the Commissioners and the Superintendents. Procedures after bringing an engineered plan to the Commissioners was explained. Paul will reach out to the Select Board.

Sewer line extension at 21 Interlaken Cross Road: John Dupras, Trinity Engineering, would like to go from Interlaken Cross Road to Mahkeenac Road to Beachwood where there is a man hole. The thought is to Install a forced main. John asked several questions; such as would he need the full design engineered to take the sewer extension to Town meeting. They will speak to neighbors to see if there is interest in joining sewer.

Update on Tuckermen's Bridge: Call with the Engineer has put moving the water main on hold as the bridge needs work first. The Select Board will have to weigh in first.

Park Street Pump Station out to bid: Several have taken out plans. There was a walk through for the sub-contractors, sub bids will be looked at next week and general contractor bids on the 24th of February.

Stockbridge Steering Committee meeting: They have not had another meeting yet.

Budgets-special articles: Mike has 7 special articles for water. Tony increased his budget by \$10,000.00, he has 2 special articles for sewer.

Peter moved to close the meeting all were in favor.
