

Sewer and Water Minutes

May 7, 2019

Present: Don Schneyer, Tom Schuler, Mike Buffoni, Peter Socha, Roxanne McCaffrey and Jennifer Carmichael, Absent: Tony Campetti. Tom made a motion to accept the minutes from April 2nd, all were in favor.

Church Street paving will begin tomorrow.

Flushing of all the hydrants has been ongoing for the last two weeks and is almost done.

Mike has not received a response from the correctional facility regarding the hydrant painting. It was sent and is in line for consideration but they have many letters/applications for work to be done.

The State Forester looks at all cutting plans submitted by our licensed forester. The job goes out to bid then a contract is signed by the Select Board. All cutting is being done legally, this year mostly ash and aspen are to be cut. Our cutting of the forest is for timber stand improvement. Once cutting is done we always plant seedlings of a variety of trees.

Keith Wilkinson Excavating is working on a water line at Quiet Knoll that feeds 3 houses, a new water service will be put in.

Neil Obenheim's old water service is under the Town culvert on Quiet Knoll Road. The water service broke last year and it was shut off at the curb stop and the service to the corp is still active and needs to be shut down so no future leaks develop. The service for the house was re-tapped on the main across the street to get the water service out of the brook. The water service was put in during the 50's and then the highway dept installed a 36" culvert over the main where the service tap was making it very difficult to access it to shut off. Mike suggested Wilkinson dig and shut the corp off and that the owner and Town split the cost due to the Town installing the culvert over the service.

Tom was thanked for an excellent Town report. Mike was thanked for attending the upcoming Town meeting.

Tom motioned to adjourn the meeting and Peter seconded all were in favor.
