

## *Sewer and Water Minutes*

*June 4, 2019*

Present: Don Schneyer, Peter Socha, Tom Schuler, Tony Campetti, Mike Buffoni, and Jennifer Carmichael. Peter made a motion to accept the minutes from May 7th, all were in favor.

Church Street water project lay down area cleanup was done mostly by Hewins in conjunction with the Tavitian drainage that was done; Ryan will do rest of cleanup including Yale Court. It is getting close to closing out the project. The catch-basins are all cleaned out. Problem with 18 Church St. sewer line; from house to sidewalk was repaired by owner and the camera showed everything complete and running through a week ago. After paving and the roller compressing the road there was a problem again with the sewer line, a camera showed the pipe in the road broken. The road will be dug up this Thursday to assess the damage.

Tony has ordered the new truck. He inquired if Lenny would like to buy the truck and Lenny declined. Tony would like to sell it and will ask any of the other Town departments if there is an interest in it otherwise, he will put it out to sell.

Mike got a call from the correctional facility and the hydrants will be painted starting next week. The Town has 150 hydrants, 130 are the Town's and 20 are private.

Keith Wilkinson Excavating is working on a water line at Quiet Knoll a 50-foot portion under the driveway has been done.

Neil Obenheim's old water service will be dug up, Mike got an estimate of \$1,900 from Wilkinson Excavating.

Mike was thanked for attending the Town meeting and staying until the end.

Tony had an estimate of approximately \$5,000 for the replacement of the radiator in the Gen-Set generator.

Mike purchased the jumping-jack for the Water and Sewer Dept. Roland LaBeau from AEM in Springfield will help Mike write up the specs for high lift pump rebuilds, it should run about \$2,500 per pump.

Tom motioned to adjourn the meeting and Peter seconded all were in favor.
