The Board discussed the following at their meeting:

Last Meeting Minutes – Last meeting minutes were reviewed and accepted as written.

**Board to Review Motor Vehicle Abatements/Issue** – The Board reviewed and signed 2019 Motor Vehicle abatement applications for bill #'s 572, 1086 & 2061.\*
