

Sewer and Water Minutes

February 4, 2020

Tom motioned to accept the minutes from January 7th and Peter seconded all were in favor.

Town counsel has informed the Commissioners that the Town has an easement at Stockbridge Gas Company.

Tom was thanked for volunteering to represent the Sewer and Water Board on the Stockbridge Bowl Task Force Committee.

The temporary road at the sewer and water plant is under consideration to be made into a permanent road.

Tony went through the draft for the Infiltration and Inflow study which the state mandates. He explained how the testing was done over 4 months. The waste water average flow was 147,000 gallons per day. Flow meters were in the manhole and read every 15 minutes.

Tony spoke to Steve Schatz at the finance meeting regarding the Park Street pump station over haul, it should be noted by the Finance Committee that as of 2018 the cost was approximately \$700,000. The need to camera the pipes on Park St. as well as Route 7 should be done, having longer pump runs instead of the shorter lines will use less energy.

The Ice Fishing Derby was cancelled for February

Peter motioned to adjourn and Tom seconded and all were in favor.
