The Board discussed the following items at their meeting:

Board to Review & Sign 2020 Motor Vehicle Warrant – Mike informed the Board that there is a warrant here that needs to be signed, they agreed to come in. When they come in they will review and sign the warrant, the bills will than get mailed out.

Board to Sign Uncollectible Abatement Sheet – Mike informed the Board that there is an abatement sheet here that needs to be signed, they agreed to come in. When they come in they will review and sign this abatement, then this will get processed.

Update on Tax Exemption Pilot Program – Tom updated Mike, Gary and Doug that there's nothing new to report since their last assessor's meeting, Mike informed Tom that the town received a letter from Austin Riggs that they contributed \$ 16,000.00 to the Pilot Program for this year.
