

**Town of Stockbridge Historic Preservation Commission**  
**Minutes of Meeting**

The Town of Stockbridge Historic Preservation Commission held a public meeting at the Town Offices on Monday, February 10, beginning at 4:00 PM. **Minutes**

**37 Mahkeenac Road**

The Commission next considered and heard an Application for Demolition (“the Application”) with respect to the house at 37 Mahkeenac Road (“the House”) owned by Joan's Beach, LLC. The Application was presented by attorney for the owner, Nicholas Arienti. The Commission reviewed the Application, which included a description of the House, photographs thereof and plans and elevations of the proposed replacement. Following the presentation and discussion, the Commission unanimously determined that the House is not a “Significant Historic Building” as defined in Section 2.6 of Article XXII of the Town Bylaws.
