## Record of Meeting

The Board discussed the following items at their meeting:

Board to Review & Sign Motor Vehicle Applications & Certificates – Mike informed the Board that there are abatement applications and certificates that need to be signed, this time they agreed on using DocuSign so they don't have to come in. Mike emailed the forms over to them, they reviewed, signed and emailed back to Mike. They will be processed this week.

CP-1 Form for FY20 – Mike informed the Board that this form has been signed and sent in by him and Ray, it was due by the 15<sup>th</sup>. Joe Barbieri has looked it over, it has been accepted by the state.

CL-1 Forms for FY22 – Mike reviewed with the Board that Tammy has sent these forms out, they are due October 1<sup>st</sup>. Before January 1<sup>st</sup> the Board will need to come in, review and sign them. A few have called and asked to be sent after the deadline, Mike agreed.

Submission on Gateway of LA-3 & New Growth for FY21 - Mike informed the Board that he has submitted the LA-3 & New Growth forms to Joe Barbieri at the state, this afternoon he will be talking to Joe to discuss these forms.

Overlay for FY21 – Mike reviewed with the Board that they usually meet to go over this number, Mike has the numbers from FY17, 18, 19 and 20. He has a rough total, he will go over this number with Ray. The number he has is \$ 172,000 that they can work with, at their next meeting they can finalize this total.

ATB Filing for Sheehan Properties – Mike reviewed with the Board that one filing came in for their properties, there may be a technicality with this that it was filed 2 days late. They will wait until this goes through the ATB than talk to their attorneys.

Update on Safety Protocols & Reopening– Mike informed the Board that we are still unsure when the town hall will be open to the public, Patrick White was at the meeting and he said nothing has been said. Mike asked about meeting in person, there is a limitation on how many people can be there and if the building is closed it needs to be televised.

Update on Tax Exemption Pilot Program – Tom updated Mike, Gary and Doug that there's nothing new to report since their last assessor's meeting, Tom will write a letter to Austin Riggs to thank them for their check.
