

Sewer and Water Minutes

June 1, 2021

Present: Don Schneyer, John Loiodice, Peter Socha, Tony Campetti, Mike Buffoni and Jennifer Carmichael. Don asked for a motion to accept the minutes from May 4, 2021, Peter motioned to accept the minutes and Don seconded, all were in favor.

The small "sink hole" issue on Elm Street was discussed. Mike will call in Dig-Safe to see if any utilities are near the curb in front of the Elm Street Market. Water and sewer lines are in the middle of the road.

Hydrant flushing has not happened but it will be done soon.

Access road to plant for sewer and water; Mike was in contact with Roxanne and Mike Canales regarding funding. Paving of the new driveway will come from monies left over from the new Town highway garage. Regarding the gate, the Town already appropriated money for this project included in security measures. Several things need to be taken care of before the paving begins, such as widening the driveway at the plant. The apron to appease the state may be done and hold off on the rest until a decision is made as to possibly paving the whole complex at 1 West Stockbridge Rd.

The Glendale Pump Station: Tony purchased a 6x6 shed, added 3 1/2 inches of insulation, cut some vents in it and enclosed the drum scrubber. A new electric motor for the drum scrubber was also purchased. The old one will be rebuilt and used as a spare. The loud noise seems to be gone. The aqua-venger liquid has cut the odor and should work well.

Larrywaug Bridge project has started and should be finished by October.

John discussed the Stockbridge Bowl Steering Committee meeting. They are trying to decide where to and what to dredge and where to deposit sediment when removed. They are also having discussions about the sewer around the lake. They also hope to harvest in certain areas of the lake this summer.

Tony and Mike concerns: Mike has one water hauler that has not paid, there are no substantial demand fees (after 30 days a charge of \$10 is applied) no interest is applied. We need to look into nonpayment penalties for the future.

Don asked for a motion to adjourn and John motioned to adjourn the June meeting and Peter seconded, all were in favor.
